WHY HOST A THIRD PARTY FUNDRAISER FOR REGENERATION?

TYPES OF EVENTS:

"A-thons", sales, parties/festivals, tournaments, entertainment, other

TIPS FOR PLANNING YOUR EVENT

- Brainstorm event
- Assign tasks
- Choose a date, time, and venue, noting any permits or licenses needed
- Develop a budget and set a fundraising goal
- Notify the Development Officer of your event
- Tap into your network and look for sponsors for food, prizes, or auction items
- Promote your event on social media, with posters, and via email
- Take photos! Use them to thank donors, promote on social media, and share with Regen
- Thank your supporters and let them know how much you've raised
- Arrange a time to deliver your funds and celebrate your success

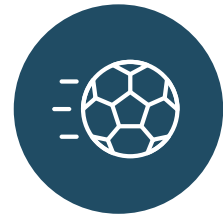

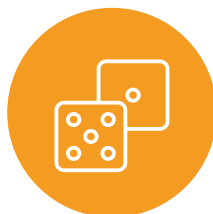

WAYS REGENERATION CAN HELP:

When you decide to host a third party fundraiser, you assume responsibility for all aspects of the event, including everything from planning to implementation. However, Regeneration is able to help in the following ways:

- Answering any questions and providing guidance throughout the planning process
- Use of Regeneration's name and logo with approval
- Use of Regeneration's marketing and informational materials
- Regeneration representative at event
- Issuing tax receipts according to CRA guidelines
- Tax receipts will be issued according to Canada Revenue Agency guidelines
- Once approved, tax receipts will be issued for gifts of \$20 and above
- Tax receipts will only be issued if full name and address of donor is provided
- Tax receipts will NOT be issued for sponsorships as the company will have received marketing value in return
- Please note that we follow strict CRA guidelines when issuing tax receipts. For example, those deemed to receive a benefit for their gift (i.e. purchasing a ticket to a concert) are not eligible
